RED-Cross: Jim, K8CAN, Reported that the Red Cross needs to raise \$25,000.00 to support families like those who have recently experienced incredible hardship from Tropical Storm Barry, wildfires in California and home fires across the country.

The Responses this month: Distributed over 14,500 relief supplies to people impacted by recent disasters.

Sheltered more than 4 dozen people over the past 3 weeks after the earthquakes in California.

Provided financial support to 30 families after a home fire in North Dakota.

Served more than 75,800 meals and snacks to families across the country.

These are just the numbers our teams in the field shared this month as of last Friday.

Disasters like these happen, no matter how tragic and devastating. But thanks to compassionate friends like YOU, we can be ready to support impacted families across the country.

On-Air-Director: Greg has two items: one is the space station will be sending SSTV transmissions till this coming Sunday. Two is on August 31th, we'll be operating the World Wide digital radio contest.

Tech Director: Steve stated we've been experiencing on and off problems with the GRARA main repeater: 147.260. Steve adjusted the squelch level, and that seemed to make a difference. Steve had Nathen, (LARC) provide his input: he thinks it's a loose wire, causing the controller to go false positive. Tom N8DGD believes the trouble is at the 92nd street location. They will be going out tomorrow to check it out.

Steve also checked out the Fusion Repeater, which seemed to have diminished range. They went to the site and discovered a bad coax connection: they replaced it and now it is working well. Ron AB8DT, has placed a digi repeater at the site.

The last problem was that folks were bringing in their radios to be programed, but didn't have the right drivers or connectors (USB) to connect to the computer. Steve wants to increase the on-board memory for the computer: \$125.00. A motion to accept was made, seconded. The motion passed.

General Discussion on the upcoming Swap:

Bob Moe, M-A-L, reported he has sold 4 tables so far. We will meet at the "Steak-N-Shake", then go on to the school building: 7PM-9PM.

The tickets have already been paid for and Jack NY8D has the food taken care of. (Hot Dogs, coffee & donuts). The grand prize was discussed and we may choose a TYT Radio.

We then discussed deciding on what amount we would need for the change fund: Steve thought \$350.00 would be idea. Steve will be in charge of getting Nic-Naks.

A question came up about our club accepting donations and handling estate sales. We decided to put a contact site on the web site for receiving donations and handling estates...
